INTRODUCTION

The increasing impact of global warming due to greenhouse gas emissions is felt by climate change in the form of rising temperatures and rising sea levels. The Kyoto Protocol has enabled a framework for reduction in emissions by industrialized countries through the advent of carbon credits.
